

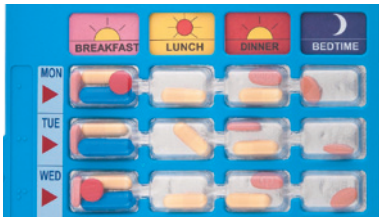
Appointment letter or card

# Coming to the Women's and Children's Hospital



When you or your child comes to the Women's and Children's Hospital in Adelaide you will be supported by the Aboriginal Liaison Officers.

It is very important you bring these items to hospital with you to make your patient journey easier:

- > Warm clothes such as jumpers or cardigans as the weather can get cold and it may also be a bit cold in the hospital
- > Shoes
- > Photo ID (e.g. Drivers licence or any ID with your photo on it)
- > Medicare Card
- > Health Care/Concession Card
- > Bank Card/Bank book
- > Basics Card (can be used at the Women's and Children's Hospital)
- > Money (limited assistance is available)
- > PATS (Patient Travel) paperwork
- > Appointment letter or card
- > Medications
- > List of medications or scripts

### Other information you need to know:

- > Medical consent can only be given by a parent or legal guardian. If you are a child's carer you will need a letter showing this or a phone number so we can contact the parent / legal guardian.
- > Accommodation and travel arrangements must be organised by your health service before you arrive. No accommodation is available at the Women's and Children's Hospital.
- > **Welfare assistance is limited and strict criteria applies.**
- > Meals will only be provided for patients, not escort.

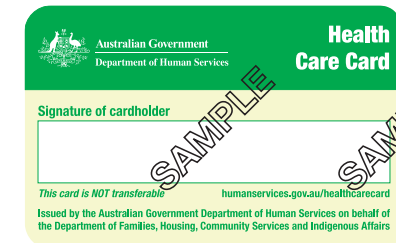

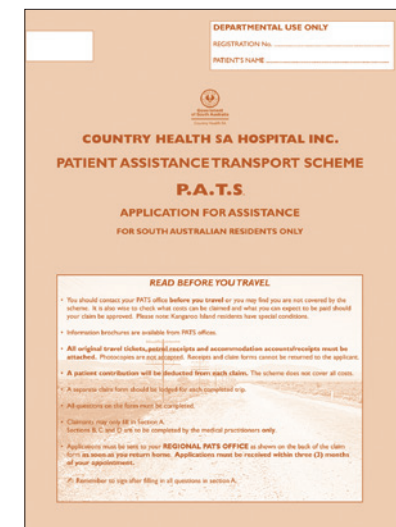
